Issues with not getting visitation or limited visitation with your child? Help is available.

Do you have legal questions or need help with completing your own legal documents—and the issue is related to your child? An Attorney from Legal Aid will be available.

Driver's License Reinstatement

Has your driver's license been suspended due to your failure to cooperate and/or make child support payments as ordered? A representative of the Child Support Enforcement Agency will be available to work with you to reinstate your driver's license and develop a plan that will help you get back on the road to providing financial support to your children. A minimum payment of \$50 will be required in order to successfully reinstate a license that has been suspended by the Coshocton County CSEA. (If there are other restrictions on your license, we cannot assist you with these.)

Child Support Arrears Forgiveness

A representative of the Coshocton County CSEA will be on hand to discuss options available to have a portion of your child support arrearages waived/forgiven. Please be advised, not all cases are eligible for this service. This is an excellent opportunity to work with the agency to reduce your child support debt. This is a NEW service!

Fatherhood Resources

A representative from the Coshocton County Fatherhood Initiative will be available to provide information on resources and events that promote healthy strong relationships between fathers and their children. Receive information on parenting programs available in the community and get access to interactive resources for fathers or father figures.

Modification of your Child Support Order

Is your child support obligation too high based on your current financial situation? There are many reasons why a child support order should be modified including the fact that the order is more than 3 years old. A representative will be available to determine whether your case is eligible for a review and provide you with tips/information on how to ensure your order is set reasonably.

PRC - Prevention, Retention and Contingency Benefits - Need Temporary Financial Help?

Are you having temporary difficulties meeting household bills? Do you need special equipment, tools, licensing in order to accept a new job offer?

Do you need car repairs or help with rent/deposits? PRC benefits are designed to assist working parents with temporary financial barriers. A representative from Coshocton County Public Assistance Division will be available to discuss your situation and schedule follow up appointments. Funds are limited and not all applications will be approved.

Job Leads, Job Training and Education Opportunities

A JFS Employment Coordinator will be available to assess your employment needs and advise on how they can assist you in obtaining employment, getting your GED, enrolling in school/training programs and other job related assistance.

Help with Visitation Issues?

A trained Mediator with Family PACT (Parents Acting Cooperatively Together) will be available to assist you with visitation issues and concerns you may be experiencing. If there is no order for parenting times/visitation with your child, they may be able to work with the other parent to obtain an agreement for visitation.

Southeastern Ohio Legal Services

A lawyer from Southeastern Ohio Legal Services will be available to evaluate your legal situation. Services will be limited to issues involving your children. SEOLS will not be able to provide direct representation at the event but will be able to advise if they can assist you with your legal issues.
